2. Institute and fully implement a new curriculum, including providing appropriate professional development for all relevant staff, that is based on scientifically based research and offers substantial promise of improving educational achievement for low-achieving students								6%
3. Significantly decrease management authority at the school level.								18%
4. Appoint an outside expert to advise the school on its progress toward making adequate yearly progress, based on its school plan.								33%
5. Extend the school year or school day for the school.								12%
6. Restructure the internal organizational structure of the school (Reconstitute)								21%
