### **AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION**

It is duly submitted for final approval by the State Board of Education, as required by Section 1005.22(1)(e)1, Florida Statutes.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Rule 6E-2.002, F.A.C., Institutional Licensure provides clarity to the criteria and process for institutions seeking provisional licensure from the Commission for Independent Education. The current rule is somewhat unclear as to the licensing process. The proposed rule will now clearly outline that the Commission may impose any conditions deemed appropriate for compliance with standards of Rule 6E-2.004, F.A.C., after reviewing applications submitted by institutions seeking provisional licensure. An itemized list of deficiencies and conditions of the application will be compiled by the Commission. Additionally, the list must be satisfied before the granting of the Provisional License.

The amendment of the rule has been approved by the Commission for Independent Education at the meeting held on December 1, 2005, following a Rules Workshop on November 30, 2005.
