For the first time in Florida's history, the Department of Education required that all students reading below grade level, as identified by scoring Level 1 or Level 2 on the FCAT in Reading, be served in a reading intervention course. The data presented will identify the percentages of students enrolled in reading intervention courses by district and FCAT achievement level in grades 6-12 for the 2005-2006 school year.
