RECOMMENDATION

On January 25, 2006, the School Board of Palm Beach County (School Board) voted to terminate the charter of Survivors Charter School, Inc., Boynton Beach (Charter School). The Charter School filed this appeal on February 27, 2006. On April 28, 2006, the Charter School Appeal Commission heard the appeal of this matter.

Thereafter, the Commission voted 7 to 0 to recommend to the State Board of Education to deny the appeal of the Charter School. The Commission's justifications for its recommendation were as follows:

1. The Commission voted 6 to 1 that the School Board **did** have competent, substantial evidence to support its finding regarding the severity of the audit findings for Survivors Boynton Beach.
2. The Commission voted 6 to 1 that the School Board's termination of the Survivors Boynton Beach charter contract based on the severity of audit findings **is** statutory good cause for immediate termination.
