| <b>Quality Educators</b>                | <p><b>School Board declares a state of emergency for all repeating F schools.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Locate and hire high quality staff (certified in area of responsibility, evidence of success as determined by student gains) for all positions</li> <li>✓ Staff in place prior to beginning of the school year, even if this means transferring teachers from other schools</li> <li>✓ Maintain quality staff in all positions yearlong, even if this means transferring teachers from other schools</li> <li>✓ Adopt Incentive system to retain quality staff</li> <li>✓ Mentors for principals and teachers</li> <li>✓ Site-based Reading and Mathematics Coaches</li> </ul> | <p><b>Staff lists with qualifications and areas of responsibility, Quarterly Assurance</b></p> |
| <b>Targeted Funding</b>                 | <p><b>School Board adopts a budget for 06-07 which includes funds targeted to top needs of F schools.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Adopt special budget category for 06-07 funds</li> <li>✓ Fully utilize state appropriated Supplemental Academic Instruction (SAI), Perkins, and Tech Prep categorical funds</li> </ul>   | <p><b>School Board Approved Budget</b></p>   |
| <b>Provision of Resources</b>           | <p><b>School Board ensures all schools have the necessary resources and materials for success</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Resources necessary to ensure an safe and orderly working and learning environment</li> <li>✓ Adequate classroom materials provided prior to the beginning of the school year in every classroom for every student</li> <li>✓ Tools necessary to implement the Continuous Improvement Model</li> </ul>   | <p><b>Quarterly Assurance</b></p>  |
| <b>End Social Promotion</b>             | <p><b>By September 1, School Board adopts policies for feeder schools that minimize promotion of unprepared students to the next school level.</b></p>  | <p><b>Policy distributed to each school</b></p>  |
| <b>Choice</b>                           | <p><b>Within 48 hours of grade designation, School Board notifies parents of School Choice options that include:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Public School Opportunity Scholarships</li> <li>✓ McKay Scholarships for students with disabilities</li> <li>✓ No Child Left Behind Choice Options</li> </ul>   | <p><b>Dated Parent Communication Documentation</b></p>   |
| <b>Community Oversight</b>              | <p><b>By September 1, School Board establishes a Community Oversight Committee for each repeating F school to:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Monitor the implementation of school and district plans</li> <li>✓ State will facilitate Committee visit and report on progress</li> </ul>  | <p><b>Documented Members Agreements to Participate</b></p>                                     |
| <b>Ensure Success of Each Student</b>   | <p><b>Within the first month of school, schools develop student success monitoring plans.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Form support teams for each student and identify goals</li> <li>✓ Support team leader coordinates plan and monitors progress</li> </ul>  | <p><b>Each student and parent knows their plan</b></p>   |
| <b>District and School Action Plans</b> | <p><b>By August 1, School Board submits web-based district and school action plans that:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Address the unique needs of the school and its community (per climate survey and student achievement data analysis)</li> <li>✓ Include components of the Continuous Improvement Model</li> <li>✓ Are aligned to performance appraisal data of teachers and administrators</li> </ul>  | <p><b>Plans on web, Progress Reports</b></p>   |
| <b>Close Double F Charter Schools</b>   | <p><b>School boards take emergency action to close double F charter schools in their districts.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Double F charter schools should not be open in the 2006-07 school year.</li> <li>✓ Parents of students attending these schools should be given choices of other schools in the district.</li> <li>✓ Reconstituted Charters that fail will be closed</li> </ul>   | <p><b>Documented School Board action</b></p>   |
