
Re: St. Petersburg College - Request Site Designation Approval for a Midtown

St. Petersburg College is seeking authorization for a special purpose center site designation for a Midtown Center, located in the Jordan Park Center for Achievement at 1048 22<sup>nd</sup> Street South, St. Petersburg, Florida. The College currently has a lease with the City of St. Petersburg Housing Authority on this 10,000-square foot property through August 2011.

This special purpose center designation request was approved by St. Petersburg College's Board of Trustees at their meeting on March 21, 2006. The site designation will allow us to request operating funds to assist with expenses at this site. **SUBJECT:** Request Site Designation for Midtown

**Approval is sought** for the College to request that the State Board of Education designate the Center for Achievement located at 1048 22<sup>nd</sup> Street South, St. Petersburg, Florida as a special purpose center, to be known as SPC Midtown.

As part of the College's strategic directive to provide quality facilities and equipment to meet student and community needs, we have an objective to expand the use of the Midtown Center to handle the increase in enrollment, and continue the expanded partnership with WorkNet Pinellas, and the City of St. Petersburg Housing Authority.

The College is requesting this designation to request operating funds and to allow the use of Public Education Capital Outlay (PECO) funds if necessary. This request will be presented to the State Board of Education at their next meeting.
