BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1011.62(1)(c), Florida Statutes (Funds of operation of schools.--) provides the basis for the annual allocation from the Florida Education Finance Program to each district for operation of schools. Rule 6A-1.09441, FAC, provides the conditions for which a student can generate funding through the Florida Education Finance Program and for which a student may earn credit toward high school graduation. The proposed rule is amended to reflect recent changes in legislation relating to student progression, high school graduation, and course requirements as well as courses requested by school districts. The Course Code Directory as proposed will become effective with the 2007-08 school year.
