SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment to Rule 6D-7.006, Student Progress Plan and Requirements for Graduation

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Rule 6D-7.006, FAC., establishes guidelines for the promotion and graduation of students enrolled in the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind. The "Student Progression Plan," as incorporated by reference in the rule, has been amended to reflect changes in statute relating to accelerated graduation options, requirements for remediation of students scoring at Level 1 or 2 on FCAT in reading and math, requirements for the promotion of middle school students, and clarification of process and procedure.

The Board of Trustees, Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, approved this rule as amended at their meeting on October 21, 2006. The State Board of Education is charged with approving or disapproving the rule as submitted by the Board of Trustees.
