Requirements Met

- ✓ School wide Reform
 - + Continues to implement the district-wide high school reform initiative
- ✓ Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform
 - + All middle grades are offering IB programs, Springboard & AVID programs
 - + All middle grade level 1 students in reading and math continue to take an additional class to improve their academic achievement
- ✓ Extended Learning with Transportation
 - + 100% of students enrolled in 7th period
- ✓ Oversight committee in place, 6 members and they are meeting monthly
- ✓ School wide Staff Development
 - + 100% (31) math teachers attended Springboard training and 24/7 training
 - + 100% (14) English teachers attended Write Score training
 - + 100% (all) of the ESE teachers attended Homework.com training
 - + 100% (16) science teachers attended Science FCAT special items training
 - + 100% (29) of beginning teachers attended training with Dr. LaStrap (11/01)
 - + 100% (11) 9th grade reading and English teachers attended data training (11/07)
 - + 141 faculty members attended best practices in mathematics (11/08)
- ✓ Staff Development in Reading
 - + Staff development in Reading in the Content area provided for all teachers
 - + Reading coaches received training in literacy instruction
- ✓ Evans is fully staffed
- ✓ District provides on-site reading coaches
 - + Four reading coaches, one per grade level, all certified in Reading
- ✓ District provides on-site math coaches
 - + Four math coaches, one per grade level, all certified in math
- ✓ Extended Day Credit Recovery Program
 - + Students in 7th period participate in credit recovery, credit retrieval, or are taking courses to increase GPA (50 students enrolled in Credit Recovery/ 79 in Academic Community Education/ 57 in Florida Virtual School)
- ✓ K-12 Reading Plan
 - + Four coaches registered- all reporting into the database

 - 95% of student contracts have been signed and 65% of parent contacts were returned signed, this is an increase from 60% in November

 - + 33% of 901 eligible students receive tutoring services
