Requirements Met

- ✓ Schoolwide Reform
 - + Components of High Schools That Work are being planned and implemented.
- ✓ Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform –
 - +Components of Making Middle Grades Work are being implemented
- ✓ The Community Assessment team met on November 20, 2006.
- ✓ Schoolwide Staff Development
 - + All teachers participated in a writing workshop and follow-up training on writing in the content area. All teachers maintain a Data/Professional Development Notebook.
- ✓ Staff Development in Reading in the Content
 - + Observed word walls in all classrooms visited.
- ✓ Fully Staffed Entire School Year, Jefferson High is currently fully staffed
- ✓ On-site Reading Coaches
 - + Coach has documented schedule for coaching.
 - + Coach has reported in the PMRN coaches log for the 11/8-11/21/06
- ✓ On-site Math Coach
 - + Coach has documented schedule for coaching.
- ✓ Extended Day Credit Recovery Program
 - + 100% of students in need of recovering credits take classes through Florida Virtual School in after school program or at the Leon County ACE program. Transportation is provided for the after school program.

Progress Toward Compliance

5. 9th Grade Contracts
 - Only 44% reported as completed, increase from 35% in November.
 - + School dean and district social worker have been directed to pursue remaining contracts.
6. Extended Learning with Transportation
 - School has 150 students registered but only 30 to 50 are in regular attendance.
 - +School is brainstorming creative alternatives to increase student participation, such as lunch and learn and before school opportunities.
