#### December Update Based on District Report

#### Requirements Met

- ✓ Schoolwide Reform
  - + Awarded 3 Innovation grants at K-12 Conference in October
- ✓ Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform
  - + components are in process
- ✓ Extended Learning with Transportation
  - + Extended learning provided through a 7<sup>th</sup> period
- ✓ Community Assessment Team is in place and has met and reported
- ✓ Jones is currently fully staffed
- ✓ District On-site Reading Coaches
  - + Four reading coaches in place, one per grade level, all certified in reading
- ✓ District On-site Math coaches
  - + Four Math Coaches in place, one per grade level, all certified in math

#### Progress Toward Compliance

5. 9<sup>th</sup> Grade Contracts
  - + 90% of student signatures have been collected, 62% of parent signatures have been collected up from 28%
6. Staff development
  - On-going although number and percent of attendees not provided on various training topics
7. Staff Development in Reading in the Content Area
  - On-going although information provided lacks sufficient detail to verify compliance
21. Extended Day Credit Recovery Program
  - 48% (138 of 290 students) are enrolled in Credit Recovery during the required 7<sup>th</sup> period
24. Participation in State Approved SES
  - District chose not to utilize Title I funds but agreed to service students with tutors; only 28% (156 of 561) Level 1 students are receiving tutoring after school
25. Implementation of State Reading Plan
  - No evidence of implementation or monitoring of state reading plan
