#### December Update Based on District Report

#### Requirements Met

- ✓ Schoolwide Reform
  - + Documented implementation of *High Schools That Work* through meetings and initial trainings.
- ✓ Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform
  - + Vertical Planning workshop – Nov 29<sup>th</sup>, 13 teachers and counselors from Miami Central; 53 teachers and counselors from Westview Middle
  - + Creating a High Performance Learning Culture workshop – Nov 27<sup>th</sup>, 8 teachers participated
  - + Nov 3 - The Aerospace Academy Recruitment Fair was held
  - + Nov 1 – Professional Learning Community for Secondary School Administrators – both Vice Principals attended
- ✓ Extended Learning with Transportation
  - + The number of students receiving tutoring represents 94% of the total student enrollment of 2,209 students. The remaining 6% are magnet students who are not enrolled in remediation.
- ✓ The District Community Assessment Team met on Nov 9<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>.
- ✓ Schoolwide Staff Development
  - + Many professional development activities are listed with the number of teachers who participated included. Three activities has an attendance of 20 participants or more.
- ✓ Staff Development in Reading Content Area
  - + To date, 82 of 177 teachers have received CRISS training; this will continue to be offered until 100% have participated.
- ✓ Miami Central is currently fully staffed
- ✓ District provides on-site reading coaches
  - + District has provided four on-site reading coaches with the scope of duties documented.
- ✓ District provides on-site math coaches
  - + District has provided four on-site math coaches with the scope of duties documented.

#### Progress Toward Compliance

5. 9th Grade Contracts
  - + The report indicates that a total of 531 contracts out of 564 (94%) have been completed; up from 63% last month.
21. Extended Day Credit Recovery Program
  - + 297 out of 403 eligible students (74%) are participating in the credit recovery program; up from 50% on last month's report.
25. Implementation of the K-12 Reading Plan
  - Only one coach registered and reporting.
