December Update Based on District Report

Requirements Met

- ✓ Schoolwide Reform
 - + Participation in follow-up workshop *Creating a High Performance Learning Culture*
- ✓ Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform
 - + Training on *Making Middle Grades Matter* (Literacy Training) on 11/17/06
 - + Two school level administrators participated in Professional Learning Community for Secondary School Administrators. (Monthly meetings of Zone School leadership started in November to identify best practices)
- ✓ Extended Learning with Transportation
 - + 100% of students continue to participate in mandatory extended 8 period day
 - + One-hundred percent (100%) of students identified as the lowest forty-percent (40%) in reading and mathematics are participating in the extended learning pull-out tutorial program: 228 students receiving reading tutoring and 178 students receiving mathematics tutoring in grades nine and ten.
 - + 117 tenth grade students are receiving additional support in writing through pull-out tutoring and 38 students are receiving support in writing during after-school tutoring.
 - + 53 eleventh grade students are receiving additional support in science through pull-out tutoring, based on their performance on bi-weekly and quarterly assessments.
 - + 47% of low performing students receiving additional tutoring in reading, an increase over participation rates reported in November
- ✓ The District Community Assessment Team held its in November meeting.
- ✓ Fully staffed, the instructional vacancy in 12th Grade Intensive Reading reported in November's report has been filled; candidate was formally appointed the week of November 27th – December 1st.
- ✓ District provides on-site reading coaches
 - + District has provided four on-site reading coaches
- ✓ District provides on-site math coaches
 - + District has provided four on-site math coaches

Progress Toward Compliance

5. 9th Grade Contracts
 - + December report indicates that a total of 215 contracts out of 217 (99%) have been completed (as of 11/28/06).
8. Schoolwide Staff Development
 - + 81% of all new teachers participated in New Educator Support Team (NEST) sessions that are scheduled twice per month (Miami Edison has 16 new teachers)
9. Staff Development in Reading Content Area
 - + *Reading Plus Training* held in November was attended by 9 teachers (or 82% of reading teachers).

21. Extended Day Credit Recovery Program
 - 73 out of 204 eligible students (35%) are participating in the credit recovery program (*Number of total students eligible increased from last month's report due to inclusion of elective courses in total number of missing credits*)
24. Participation in State Approved SES
 - 372 parents of eligible students from Miami Edison Senior High School completed applications for SES; 160 students were enrolled in SES (or 43% of those that applied); 19 fewer than reported in November report (November's report indicated 179 requests for SES services).
25. Faithful implementation of the approved K-12 Reading Plan
 - K-12 plan requires reading coaches to report their time to PMRN: 4 coaches registered, but only 1 reporting.
