6A-1.09531 Minimum School Day for Emergency Situations. Where conditions necessitate that a school board must operate a school program at any school center within the district for less than the minimum school day as prescribed by Section 228.041(13), Florida Statutes, the Commissioner upon application of the school board, may reduce the minimum school day by not more than one (1) hour for one hundred twenty (120) school days. Any application to the Commissioner for a reduction of the minimum school day prescribed by Section 228.041(13), Florida Statutes, shall be in writing and shall set forth in detail the nature of the emergency and the reasons why a reduction is necessary for a certain day or days. The Commissioner is authorized to approve, for a period not to exceed one hundred twenty (120) school days, those applications describing emergency situations which he or she finds might endanger the health, safety or welfare of students in the public schools of Florida.
