## In Compliance:

### ***School-wide Reform:***

Plans are underway for both remedial and enrichment summer programs. The school is also planning to develop an advanced placement program.

### ***Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform:***

A vertical team workshop for middle and high school teachers targeting AP mathematics courses are planned.

### ***Extended Learning with Transportation:***

Jefferson High School highlighted their Diversified Cooperative Training (DCT) program which currently serves 15 students.

### ***Community Assessment Team:***

The Community Assessment Team met on March 28, 2007.

### ***School-wide Staff Development:***

The district offers opportunities for individuals and small groups to attend a variety of professional development activities.

### ***Staff Development in Reading:***

There has been faculty-wide training on vocabulary strategies. Jefferson High School continues to access resources through their FLARE consultant.

### ***Fully Staffed Entire School Year:***

Jefferson County High School is fully staffed.

### ***District On-site Reading Coaches:***

The school reports teacher support activities as well as professional development for the coach.

### ***District On-site Math Coach:***

The coach activities include the development of a math focus calendar and other reported activities.

### ***Extended Day Credit Recovery Program:***

Fifteen students earned enough credits to move to next grade level through credit recovery. Currently sixteen students have enrolled in Florida Virtual School.

### ***Participation in State Approved SES:***

The school reports outreach efforts for all eligible students to receive SES services. The District currently supports six students for SES.
