## In Compliance:

### ***School-wide Reform:***

Miami Jackson participated in a *High Schools That Work* coordinators meeting. March 22-24, 2007, the Co-principals and a Vice Principal participated in the Miami-Dade Leadership Development Institute sponsored by Harvard University.

### ***Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform:***

A Professional Learning Community meeting was held on March 15, 2007, with feeder pattern schools.

### ***Extended Learning with Transportation:***

One hundred percent of students participate in an extended day program with transportation.

### ***District Community Assessment Team (DCAT):***

The DCAT Committee meets monthly. The last meeting was held on March 20, 2007; all reports have been submitted.

### ***School-wide Staff Development:***

To date, 20 of 29 required professional development activities had 100% participation; 100% of reading teachers have participated in disaggregating student data with the school principals; 100% of teachers have participated in professional development beyond the school day.

### ***Staff Development in Reading:***

School-wide professional development *Reading in the Content Areas* was conducted on March 16, 2007.

### ***Fully Staffed Entire School Year:***

Miami Jackson Senior High School is fully staffed. The district also continues to provide assistance as necessary.

### ***District Provides Onsite Reading Coaches:***

There is one Reading Coach per grade level.

### ***District Provides Onsite Math Coaches:***

There is one Math Coach per grade level.

## Areas of Concern:

### ***Extended Day Credit Recovery Program:***

The extended day credit recovery program is in place but participation continues to hover just above 50%.
