Analysis of the 26 Requirements

## In Compliance:

### ***School-wide Reform:***

Ribault continues to implement the school-wide reform model for all students.

- Twelve students have finished the FastForward Program, representing a 23% increase in student course completion since February 28, 2007.
- Staff at Ribault made a site visit to New Smyrna Beach High School (school match) on March 28, 2007.

### ***Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform:***

To date, 13 of 24 applicants have been accepted for the 2007-2008 *Early College Program*. Ribault continues to recruit students from its feeder schools and is planning a one week *Summer Bridge Program* for rising 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> grade students.

### ***Extended Learning Program with Transportation:***

Although the report indicates a decrease in attendance for after school math, science, reading, and Saturday school, Ribault has implemented strategies to increase attendance.

- Ribault Renaissance Initiative has scheduled a meeting with Comcast personnel, school based administrators and CAT members to deliver targeted public service announcements with a new message to students and families encouraging attendance in After School and Saturday School tutoring.
- An automobile raffle will be held in May for students attending tutoring.

### ***District Community Assessment Team (CAT):***

The Community Assessment Team submitted a written request to the district to fund a summer Reading, Math, and Science program. The Team continues to meet monthly and provide updates to the school, district, and state.

### ***School-wide Staff Development:***

Two school-wide staff development activities were held in March:

- 74 of 87 teachers attended *Student Engagement: Engaging Students through Relevant Rigorous Work* on 3/14/07.
- 57 of 87 teachers attended *Evaluating Student Progress using Data* on 3/28/07.

### ***Staff Development in Reading:***

The following staff development activities in reading were held in March:

- 87 of 87 teachers attended *FCAT Test Administrators Manual* on 3/1/07.
- 58 of 87 teachers attended *Increasing Rigor in all Content Areas* on 3/27/07.

### ***Fully Staffed Entire School Year:***

Ribault High School is fully staffed.

***District Provides Onsite Reading Coaches:***

There are four reading coaches, one per grade level, with monthly focus areas listed.

***District Provides Onsite Math Coaches:***

There are four math coaches, one per grade level, with monthly focus areas listed.

***Extended Day Credit Recovery Program:***

Enrollment in the credit recovery program has a total increase of 16 students for all grade levels.

**Areas of Concern:**

***9<sup>th</sup> Grade Contracts:***

Ribault has collected 20 *Covenants of Success* contracts (total 240) since the last report, reflecting approximately 50% of the ninth grade student population.
