1012.56(8), Florida Statutes

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1012.56(8), F.S., requires the State Board of Education to specify, by rule, the examination scores required for the issuance of a professional certificate and temporary certificate. Such rules must define examination competencies and establish uniform evaluation guidelines.

State Board of Education Rule 6A-4.0021, FAC, fulfills the above requirement by providing a description, by reference, of the competencies and skills to be assessed. These competencies and skills are included in the document *Competencies and Skills Required for Teacher Certification in Florida*. As changes to general knowledge, professional education, and subject area competencies are made, a new edition of this document must be developed and incorporated, by reference, into the rule.

At this time, an amendment is requested to adopt the twelfth edition of the *Competencies and Skills* document and to specify the effective date for the implementation of the new competencies and skills. Once approved, this new edition of the document will be made available to examination candidates and institutions providing teacher education programs.
