Analysis of the 26 Requirements

HIGHLIGHTING SUCCESS:

The results of the 2007 FCAT Writing + indicated 81% of all students at Ribault scored at or above 3.5. This is a 16 percentage point increase from the 2006 FCAT Writing results. This is one of the highest scores in the district and the largest gain experienced by a school in the district.

In Compliance:

School-wide Reform:

Ribault continues to implement the school-wide reform model for all students.

- Staff at Ribault made a site visit to Middleton High in Tampa on 4/17/07 and Forest Hill Community School in Palm Beach Gardens from 4/23/07-4/25/07 in support of district efforts with High School Redesign.

Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform:

To date, 15 of 29 student applicants have been accepted to the 2007-2008 *Early College Program*.

Extended Learning Program with Transportation:

Although the attendance for after school math, science, reading, and Saturday school continue to remain low, Ribault has implemented strategies to increase attendance:

- A Public Service Announcement will air on Channel 14 the first week in June on attendance for the Summer Academy.
- The District will implement a telephone looping system for all students to encourage participation in After School, Saturday School and the Summer Academy.

District Community Assessment Team (CAT):

The Community Assessment Team met on 4/20/07. The Team discussed with the District representative technology concerns, computer to student ratio, as well as marketing for the Summer Academy. The next meeting will be held on 5/4/07.

School-wide Staff Development:

Two school-wide staff development activities were held in April:

- 73 of 87 teachers attended *Review on Individual Professional Development Plans* on 4/11/07.
- 42 of 87 teachers attended the *FlaRe Implementation of Research Based Strategies Student Engagement: Engaging Students through Relevant Rigorous Work* on 4/17/07.
- 66 of 87 teachers attended the *Self Evaluation: School Improvement Plan* on 4/25/07.

Staff Development in Reading:

The following staff development activities in reading were held in April:

- 46 of 87 teachers attended *Responding in Writing* on 4/3/07
- 65 of 87 teachers attended *Incorporating Comprehension Check in Work Period* on 4/10/07.

Fully Staffed Entire School Year:

Ribault High School is fully staffed.

District Provides Onsite Reading Coaches:

There are four reading coaches, one per grade level, with monthly focus areas listed.

District Provides Onsite Math Coaches:

There are four math coaches, one per grade level, with monthly focus areas listed.

Extended Day Credit Recovery Program:

Enrollment in the credit recovery program has a total increase of 23 students for all grade levels since the last report.

Areas of Concern:

9th Grade Contracts:

Ribault has collected an additional 21 *Covenants of Success* contracts (total 261) since the last report, reflecting approximately 62% of the ninth grade student population.

Extended Learning Program with Transportation:

The progress data reported from the school-wide “scrimmage” indicated a drop in the percentage of students scoring above the average score for both 9th and 10th grade students.
