Analysis of the 26 Requirements

HIGHLIGHTING SUCCESS:

The results of the 2007 FCAT Writing + indicated that 63% of all students at Evans scored at or above 3.5. This is a 10 percentage point increase from the 2006 FCAT Writing results.

In Compliance:

School-wide Reform:

- Jones and Evans High School principals attended the Florida Partnership Conference in Orlando on 4/24/07-4/25/07. The conference featured CollegeEd, a College Board program designed to give all students the very best college planning, academic preparation and counseling.
- Evans High School hosted a Middle School Night for all incoming freshmen on 04/11/07.
- The principal and three teachers visited a model Smaller Learning Community (SLC) school in Chicago, IL on 04/15-16/07.

Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform:

- During the month of April, the principals, guidance counselors and magnet coordinators from Evans and Jones high schools visited feeder middle schools to provide orientation and registration for summer school 2007 and SY 2007-2008.
- Evans continues to promote the 2007-08 IB program to feeder middle schools.

9th Grade Contracts:

84% of parent contracts have been returned signed to date. That is a 3% increase from last month.

Extended Learning with Transportation:

Currently, 100% of students are enrolled in extended school day and transportation is provided.

District Community Assessment Team:

The six member Committee met 4/10/07. The team discussed science and strategies to improve instruction. They also discussed diversified ways to improve instruction in all areas. Evans continues to have community meetings for parents transitioning into Evans.

School-wide Staff Development:

- Four math and reading coaches (100%), the science coach, and two administrators at Jones and Evans attended a data analysis meeting hosted by the district Accountability and Assessment department on 4/2/07.

- The science coach at Evans High School attended the “Smart Science Approach” workshop on 4/4/07. The workshop emphasized differentiated instruction.
- Evans’ UCF Literacy Consultant presented a workshop on 4/16/07 and 4/19/07 to all ninth grade English and social studies teachers that focused on vocabulary and Marzano’s reading strategies.
- Eleven of 16 (68%) science teachers at Evans High Schools and the science coach attended the UCF Science Inquiry Workshop on 4/18/07.

Staff Development in Reading:

- School wide staff developments have been conducted in reading in the content area for all departments.
- On 04/11/07, four reading coaches from Evans and Jones high schools attended a district-wide staff development designed for reading coaches.
- On 04/17/07, Melba Johnson, trainer for Thinking Maps and Write for the Future, presented best practices for reference and research to 9th and 10th grade English and social studies teachers.

Fully Staffed Entire School Year:

Evans is fully staffed.

District Provides On-site Reading Coaches:

Evans has four reading coaches, one per grade level; all are certified in reading.

District Provides On-site Math Coaches:

Evans has four math coaches, one per grade level; all are certified in secondary math.

Extended Day Credit Recovery Program:

100% of students have the opportunity to participate in extended learning. 303 students at Evans High School are participating in credit recovery or credit retrieval programs. Transportation is being provided daily.

State Approved SES:

During the day, 100% of the Level 1 students are receiving tutorial support. Evans has 328 (40%) of 825 eligible Level 1 students received tutoring services.

District Must Document Faithful Implementation of the Approved K-12 Reading Plan:

Administrators at Jones and Evans continue to meet weekly with reading coaches and reading teachers to review data, address concerns, and provide interventions.
