Targeted Funding	School Board adopts a budget for 07-08 includes funds targeted to critical needs of F schools. ✓ Adopt special budget category for 07-08 funds ✓ Dedicated Board-approved funding for required school-wide interventions ✓ Fully utilize state appropriated Supplemental Academic Instruction (SAI) Perkins, and Tech Prep categorical funds	School Board Approved Budget
Provision of Resources	School Board ensures all schools have the necessary resources and materials for success ✓ Resources necessary to ensure a safe and orderly working and learning environment ✓ Adequate classroom materials provided prior to the beginning of the school year in every classroom for every student ✓ Tools necessary to implement Florida's Continuous Improvement Model	<b>Quarterly Assurance</b>
End Social Promotion	By August 17, School Board adopts policies for feeder schools that minimize promotion of unprepared students to the next school level.	Policy distributed to each school
Ensure Success of Each Student	Within the first month of school, implement a student <b>progress monitoring system</b> and contract for each 9 <sup>th</sup> grade student attending an F school (including D Former F). ✓ Form support teams for students and identify goals ✓ Support team leader coordinates plan and monitors progress	Each student and parent knows their plan <b>Quarterly Progress Reports</b>
District and School Action Plans	By August 17, School Board submits web-based district action plan that: ✓ Address the unique needs of the school and its community (per climate survey and student achievement data analysis) ✓ Include components of Florida's Continuous Improvement Model ✓ Are aligned to performance appraisal data of teachers and administrators	Plans on web, <b>Quarterly Progress Reports</b>
Close Double F Charter Schools	School Boards take emergency action to close double F charter schools in their districts. ✓ Double F charter schools should not be open in the 2007-2008 school year. ✓ Parents of students attending these schools should be given choices of other schools in the district. ✓ Reconstituted charters that fail will be closed.
