## In Compliance:

### ***School-wide Reform:***

In September, series of workshops will be given to the community to share information on Ribault's new Career Academy for the 2007-2008 school year.

### ***Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform:***

To date, 35 of 52 applicants have been accepted for the 2007-2008 Early College Program. Ribault continues to recruit students from its feeder schools and is planning a one week "Summer Bridge Program" for rising eighth and ninth grade students. At this point, they are anticipating at least 85 students to participate in the program. In August 2007, a two day orientation will be given to new Pre-IB students.

### ***Extended Learning Program with Transportation:***

Although the attendance for after-school math, science, reading, and Saturday school continues to remain low, Ribault has implemented strategies to increase attendance. A Public Service Announcement will air on Channel 14 the first week in June regarding attendance for the Summer Academy. The District continues to implement a telephone looping system for all students to encourage participation in After School, Saturday School and the Summer Academy.

### ***District Community Assessment Team (CAT):***

The Community Assessment Team met on May 4, 2007. The team discussed various venues for reaching parents such as website, phone calls, letters regarding IB program applications, and tutoring. The next meeting is scheduled for June 8, 2007.

### ***School-wide Staff Development:***

School-wide staff development occurred on May 16, 2007: "Professional Learning Community protocols; Data Analysis."

### ***Staff Development in Reading:***

There were Block Training Sessions held on May 8, 2007: "Planning use of DeSensi Toolkit for 2007-2008."

### ***Fully Staffed Entire School-Year:***

Ribault High School is fully staffed.

### ***District Provides Onsite Reading Coaches:***

There are four reading coaches, one per grade level, with monthly focus areas listed.

### ***District Provides Onsite Math Coaches:***

There are four math coaches, one per grade level, with monthly focus areas listed.

### ***Extended Day Credit Recovery Program:***

Enrollment in the credit recovery program has increased for all grade levels.

Areas of Concern:

***9<sup>th</sup> Grade Contracts:***

Ribault has collected a total of 267 “Covenants of Success” contracts, an increase of 6 contracts since the last report.

***Extended Learning Program with Transportation:***

Athletic Programs ended the 1<sup>st</sup> week of May and transportation ended May 16<sup>th</sup> therefore the enrollment in athletic attendance dropped from 50 to 14 students.
