In Compliance:

School-wide Reform:

Evans High School continues to implement the district-wide high school reform initiative. Evans hosted an Advanced Placement night with the University of Florida Alliance on May 7, 2007. Parents, students, administration from Evans High School, and officials from the University of Florida discussed the academic plan and rigor for students taking Advanced Placement courses. Evans conducted a presentation of the IB-MYP Program to all incoming freshman on May 7, 2007. Discussion included curriculum, introduction of key staff members and emphasized the program rigor and progression plan. Evans met with a College Board representative to finalize summer opportunities offered to Evans' students. Evans will be offering an SAT Prep class and a Summer Science and Math Camp. Both opportunities are being funded through College Board.

Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform:

Evans continues to promote the 2007-08 IB program to feeder middle schools.

9th Grade Contracts:

Evans has collected 85% of parent contracts since the last report.

Extended Learning with Transportation:

There are 100% of students enrolled in 7th period.

District Community Assessment Team (CAT):

A monthly meeting is held with the six member committee.

School-wide Staff Development:

On May 5, 2007, eight of sixteen (50%) science teachers from Evans High School attended a three-hour science training. Teachers were trained on how to use computer simulated physics labs. On May 2 and 3, 2007, four reading coaches and all department chairpersons from Evans High School attended C.R.I.S.S. training. On May 24 and 25, 2007, seven of sixteen science teachers (44%) and the science coach from Evans High School attended a five-day inquiry-based science training hosted at Evans High School.

Staff Development in Reading:

On May 10, 2007, reading coaches from Evans attended a district-wide reading coach meeting. During the week of May 13, two reading coaches from Evans High School attended the “Literacy Without Boundaries: International Reading Association Convention” in Toronto, Canada.

Fully Staffed Entire School Year:

Evans High School is fully staffed.

District Provides On-Site Reading Coaches:

There are four reading coaches, one per grade level, all certified in Reading.

District Provides On-Site Math Coaches:

There are four math coaches, one per grade level, all certified in Mathematics.

Extended Day Credit Recovery Program:

There are 303 students at Evans participating in credit recovery or credit retrieval programs.

State Approved SES:

There are 328 (40%) of 825 eligible Level 1 students receiving tutoring services.

K-12 Reading Plan:

Administrators at Evans meet weekly with reading coaches and reading teachers to review data, address concerns, and provide interventions.
