In Compliance:

School-wide Reform:

ESE students will be participating in an inclusion model summer school program for remediation. An intensive language arts, math and science program will be offered to Level 1 and 2 middle school students.

Aligned Feeder Pattern Reform:

An Advanced Placement Program will be introduced for 2007-08. Pre-AP courses will also be offered to prepare students for the high school program.

Extended Learning with Transportation:

Three different Summer Programs are being offered:

- Florida Virtual School (Credit Recovery)
- Jump Start – Students get the opportunity to enhance academic skills for the upcoming school year.
- College Board Math and Science Enhancement – Prepares students for Pre-AP courses.

Community Assessment Team:

The Community Assessment Team met on May 30, 2007.

School-wide Staff Development:

The following staff development activities were provided during May:

- AP attended Leadership Forum IV
- Vision teacher attended the Regional LATS Meeting
- Three teachers visited the Lincoln High School program
- Five faculty members met with the College Board
- The Curriculum Specialist visited the Lincoln High School AP Program Coordinator

Staff Development in Reading:

Since the last report, two Reading Coaches and two teachers attended the Differentiated Instruction Train the Trainer Meeting.

Fully Staffed Entire School Year:

Jefferson County High School is fully staffed.

District On-site Reading Coaches:

Jefferson County High School has at least one full time Reading Coach.
