**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Florida began the revision process of the Mathematics Sunshine State Standards in September 2006. International, national, and state level experts in standards writing, mathematics content, and mathematics instruction have participated in the process of defining new world class Mathematics Sunshine State Standards for Florida. Major differences include: fewer benchmarks per grade level K-8, moving from an average of 83 to 20; and Bodies of Knowledge and the secondary level that include: Algebra, Calculus, Discrete Mathematics, Financial Literacy, Geometry, Probability, Statistics, and Trigonometry.
