Highlights

- 100% of faculty will take part in 56 hours of professional development provided by the district.
- There is a reading and math coach for each grade level.
- 96% of all teachers and counselors attended collaborative planning task card professional development.

Updates

- Saturday tutoring began on October 5, 2007.
- Six teachers are currently seeking the reading endorsement.
- Level 1 students are getting back-to-back 90 minute reading classes.
- Student / parent / teacher contracts have 100% compliance between teacher and student and 67% (139 out of 205) of the signed contracts have been returned.
- Teachers who have demonstrated documented student learning gains teach students identified as Level 1 in mathematics.

Concerns

- Creating Independence Through Student Owned Strategies (CRISS) professional development scheduled for October has been postponed to a later date.
- Significant rise in absenteeism from September (6.01%) to October (10.6%).
- The number of students with 6-14 absences was 36 in September and increased to 67 in October.
