#### Highlights

- Monthly activity logs have been provided for all reading and math coaches.
- District Community Assessment Team met in October with 12 (71%) attendees.

#### Updates

- October school-wide reform activities included:
  - College Awareness Center opened in media center.
  - Data chats with Level 1 and Level 2 students.
- October school-wide reform activities with feeder schools included:
  - Administrators Vertical Team Meeting with Miami Central.
  - SAT Workshops for Florida Partnership School Training.
  - Vertical Teams for Florida Partnership School Training.
- October attendance reflects:
  - 5.7% absent compared to 5.81% for September.
  - 40 students with 6-14 absences compared to 52 in September.
  - 30 in-school and out-of-school suspensions compared to 40 in September.
  - 16 students processed for truancy compared to 0 in September.
- The number of students participating in tutoring:
  - Reading increased from 105 to 225 students.
  - Math increased from 70 to 160 students.
  - Science increased from 14 to 147 students.
- All 12 October professional development activities had 100% of required teachers in attendance.

#### Concerns

- The number of teachers seeking and completing reading endorsement and competencies.
