Highlights

- Miami Central and its two feeder middle schools (Madison and Westview) have scheduled vertical articulation meetings for November 21st, December 19th, January 23rd, February 2nd, March 19th, April 23rd, and May 21st.
- *The High Schools That Work (HSTW)* ten core principles continue to be infused into Central's daily instructional delivery. Classroom visits were conducted by HSTW representatives on September 19, 2007.

Updates

- Attendance rates:
 - 14.5% absent in October compared to 8.45% in September.
 - 340 students had 6-14 absences in October compared to 49 in September.
 - 93 suspensions compared to 65 in September.
- 96 students have been flagged for truancy in October compared to 0 in September.
- Professional Development activities/ Reading Endorsement program:
 - Nine teachers have completed Competencies One and Two.
 - Thirteen have completed Competency Three.
 - Nine have completed Competencies Four and Five.
 - Two teachers are currently registered for Competency Six.
- The District Community Assessment Team met on Oct. 17, 2007.

Concerns

- Saturday Reading and Math tutoring includes:
 - 60 of 618 eligible ninth grade students.
 - 35 of 433 eligible tenth grade students.
- 60 of 611 re-takers eligible for tutoring in Reading attend Saturday school.
- 19 of 382 re-takers eligible for tutoring in Math attend Saturday school.
