Highlights

- After-school programs are established for struggling students.
- Reading-specific and general professional development activities are in place every week through professional learning communities.

Updates

- Both reading coaches are currently reporting on the PMRN.
- Two reading intervention teachers will complete reading endorsement by the end of the school year.

Concerns

- All reading intervention teachers are out of field and some have not begun work towards certification or endorsement.
- Only four of the five required coaches are currently on staff.
- There are two vacancies: ESE math and Graduation Initiative (will teach intensive reading and intensive math).
- The participation rates in after-school programs include 105 students, which is 31% of the total required to attend.
- The school revised the ninth grade contract and will send it home on November 19, 2007.
- Reading coaches' logs reveal a low percentage of time devoted to modeling in classrooms.
