Highlights

- The school has a new math/science coach who is assisting teachers in using data to guide instruction.
- The Community Assessment Team met twice this month.

Updates

- One student was referred to the Truancy office, nine students had three to five excused absences, and six were chronically tardy.
- There were 28 students suspended out-of-school.
- Supplemental Educational Services (SES) for reading and math Level 1 and 2 students began October 23rd.
- Tutoring is provided for eighth graders in science and writing every other Wednesday.
- The principal, five staff members, and the district representative participated in the DOE-sponsored FCIM training.

Concerns

- Disciplinary actions increased in October.
- low results from the district's fall benchmark testing in reading and math and the pre-test results in science and writing. The percentages of students showing mastery are as follows.
