## Highlights

- Thirty-one Level 1 and 2 students are participating in the *FastForWord* lab.
- Overall, 83 students participated in the *FastForWord* lab in October. The performance by skill increased from last month in all four skills areas: Language Accuracy (24% to 47%); Phonological Awareness (45% to 71%); Working Memory (69% to 91%); and Language Structures (68% to 92%).
- Instructional staff attended the Quality Academy training in October.

## Updates

- Student enrollment decreased from 451 to 425 in October.
- Attendance for October was 93% (96% last month) and tardies were 7% (3% last month).
- There were three out-of-school suspensions as compared to six last month.
- Wayman Academy's instructional staff participated in Differentiated Instruction (100%) and Quality Academy (91%). 92% of the school staff (48 out of 52) participated in Foundations training to assess the school's culture and climate.
- The Community Assessment Team is planning to establish business partners to help upgrade the school's library.
- In September, Wayman Academy conducted a contract signing date for grades 3-5 students with a 70% return rate and in October, 34 out of 80 parent contracts were returned for students in grades K-2.

## Concerns

- A fourth grade reading teacher resigned on October 19<sup>th</sup> and a fifth grade science teacher resigned on October 26<sup>th</sup>.
- Science coach vacancy.
- Discipline referrals increased from 13 in September to 55 in October.
- Supplemental Education Services (SES) was delayed.
- The Wayman Academy Community Assessment Team met on October 18, 2007 with four out of ten members.
