Highlights

- Waterford/Success Maker training was provided (100% participation-17 teachers).
- A team consisting of five attended FCIM on October 7th and 8th.

Updates

- The school provided training to faculty related to Florida's Continuous Improvement Model (FCIM).
- There are 43 students eligible for tutoring; 40 (93%) participate in 21st Century; and 43 (100%) participate in tutoring during the school day.
- There are 65 students enrolled in the Boys and Girls Club and they average 41 students per day (63%).

Concerns

- There were multiple reading staff development opportunities; however, they did not address reading in the content area.
- As of October 31, 2007, the school still has two vacancies (sixth and third grade positions).
- The attendance rate decreased from 98% to 88% from September to October.
- The school reports administering benchmark assessments in math for students in grades 3-6, but there is no reference for students in K-2.
- Only 39% of the student/parent contracts have been returned.
