Highlights

- Student attendance increased to 98.9 % compared to 97.48% in 2006.
- Advanced Placement teachers also instruct remediation classes.
- Principal attended College Board Institute.

Updates

- 163 students participated in 21st Century Extended Day (30% of eligible students).
- 10th graders showed highest learning gains on October Progress Checks.
- Regular data analysis meetings are held with data walls displaying progress.
- FLaRE training for administrators and reading coaches was held on October 31.
- *Read 180* training was provided with the consultant for all intensive reading teachers (100%).
- *Teaching for Results* and *FCAT Rubric* training were provided and 95% of the instructional and para- professional staff attended.

Concerns

- Currently, there are two vacancies; one intensive math and one science teacher.
- District support staff position remains vacant.
- 115 of 310 (37%) ninth grade parent contracts have been returned.
