Highlights

- There is an increased focus on attendance utilizing the Social Worker: Only 4% (91 students) have 5 or more absences in a 30 day period.

Updates

- On October 3, 2007, 134 out of 145 (92%) faculty members attended training on Positive Behavior Support (PBS) behavioral management program; on October 17, 2007, 133 out of 154 (73%) faculty members attended Dr. Janet Zadina's "Brain Compatible Learning Environment" workshop; and September 25, 2007, Springboard and reading teachers attended Facilitating Rigor (100%).
- All Advancement Via Individual Determination (AVID) teachers have been trained in AVID.
- Evans currently has 65 students enrolled in the AVID program; 53 students enrolled in Florida Virtual School; 90 in Adult Continuing Education courses; and 86 students enrolled in Ed Options Credit Recovery.

Concerns

- 561 students out of 641 (88%) ninth grade students have returned the student contracts. 258 parents out of 641(40%) have returned the parent contracts.
- 9% (93/997) of Level 1 Reading students participated in after-school tutoring.
- 19% (90/480) of Level 1 Mathematics students participated in after-school tutoring.
