Highlights

- Fifteen science teachers, (100% of those designated), participated in Creating Independence Through Student Owned Strategies (CRISS) training.
- Seventeen teachers, (100% of those designated), completed the Florida Online Reading Professional Development (FOR-PD) for the reading endorsement.

Updates

- The return of student and parent contracts increased slightly with 619 students out of 695 (89%), and 401 parents out of 695 (58%) submitting contracts.
- The attendance rate increased slightly from 93% in September to 95.4% in October.

Concerns

- September 24 to October 24, 2007, in-school suspensions totaled 210 and out-of-school suspensions totaled 98 as compared to 73 in-school suspensions and 49 out-of-school suspensions from the previous month.
- The Level 1 and Level 2 participation rate in reading tutoring continues to be low with only 180 (23%) students out of 795 students participating.
- The Level 1 and Level 2 participation rate in math tutoring continues to be low with only 170 (26%) students out of 650 students participating.
