BACKGROUND INFORMATION

One of the requirements for the athletic coaching endorsement and the stand alone athletic coaching certificate is a valid completion certificate or card in cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training. The purpose of the rule amendment is to provide for acceptance of completion certificates or cards for cardiopulmonary resuscitation courses as approved and deemed equivalent to the American Red Cross and American Heart Association by the Florida Department of Health pursuant to Rule 64E-2.038, FAC.
