**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Rule 6A-14.0061, Florida Administrative Code (FAC), entitled "Campus, Center, Special Purpose Center and Instructional Site Designations" provides that the State Board of Education review and recommend for or against the establishment of campuses, centers and special purpose centers. To obtain state capital outlay and operating support, the facilities must be designated a campus, center or special purpose center. Based on the documentation presented by the college, all the criteria stipulated in Rule 6A-14.0061, FAC are satisfied. The college is requesting to change the designation of their longstanding Reddoch Annex Instructional Site to the Reddoch Special Purpose Center. The Annex has been owned by the college since 1997. The college provides training for law enforcement, fire and correctional officers at the Annex. The Annex has operated with local resources of the college and participating departments. A special purpose center designation will allow the college to receive funding from the state for the operations and maintenance of the buildings on the site. The primary threshold for a Special Purpose Center in Rule 6A-14.0061(3) FAC, is that a site have a limited number of special, clearly defined programs or services, such as instruction or administration and this request satisfies that guideline.
