BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 2 of House Bill 511 from the 2007 Legislative Session states, "The State Board of Education shall identify any reporting requirements in state law which duplicate the requirements for reporting under the federal *No Child Left Behind Act* and make recommendations to the Legislature by December 1, 2007, for eliminating duplicative requirements in law."

The Department compared state and federal requirements and determined that, due to the sophisticated data collection system that Florida enjoys, there are no duplicative local reporting requirements between state statute and *No Child Left Behind*.
