## **Highlights**

- The school continues to be fully staffed.
- Attendance rates are at 94%, which is 9% higher than the same period last year.
- Through the Community Assessment Team, the City of Fort Lauderdale pledged trees for the Arthur Ashe campus.

## **Updates**

- One ESE position became vacant in October and has been filled.
- There have been 90 out-of-school suspensions to date. This is compared to 196 for the first quarter in 2006/2007.
- 100% of reading teachers have participated in all professional development activities.
- All Level 1 students receive 110 minutes of reading daily.
- The FLaRE coordinator regularly provides basis support and professional development.

## **Concerns**

- A full time district assigned staff member is not in place to assist with implementation of the State Board Plan.
