Highlights

- The Community Assessment Team is large and members are actively engaged.
- School-wide staff development had 100% participation.

Updates

- The one vacancy (Language Arts) will be filled by a qualified teacher by the middle of November.
- The attendance rate is 94.82% with 79 students missing 10 or more days; 48 out-of-school suspensions and 65 in-school suspensions.

Concerns

- Staff development in Reading in the Content Area dropped from 100% participation in September to 30% or less in October.
 - McREL Reading in the Content Area
 - 6 out of 20 participated on 10/6/2007
 - 4 out of 22 on participated on 10/27/2007
- Fulltime coaches in Mathematics and Science are still needed.
- Contracts were provided to students in November, therefore no data is available to report on those returned.
- Florida's Continuous Improvement Model is being implemented at the academic department level rather than as a school-wide instructional focus with shared mini-lessons and mini-assessments.
- Alignment of the model in feeder schools is unclear.
