**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The purpose of this new rule is to implement Section 1008.331, Florida Statutes, and provide provisions for implementing supplemental educational services in Title I schools identified as in need of improvement as authorized in the No Child Left Behind (NCLB) Act. In summary, the rule provides a process for applying to be a SES provider and includes provisions for monitoring, evaluating, and reporting as well as a complaint process.
