BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1007.33, Florida Statute provides authority for community colleges to develop proposals to deliver specified baccalaureate degree programs to meet local workforce needs. Section 1007.33 (3)(d), Florida Statute states that a community college that plans to submit a (baccalaureate) proposal shall submit a notice of its intent to the State Board of Education...at least 90 days prior to submitting the proposal.
