BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The School Code Rewrite changed the term “vocational education” to “career and technical education” and changed the education statute numbers. This proposed amendment changes terms and education statute numbers so that the terms and statute numbers in the rule agree with terms and statute numbers in Florida Statutes.

In addition, the Department of Education is responsible for the development of program standards and industry-driven benchmarks for career, adult, and community education programs, which must be updated every 3 years.

The Division of Workforce Education requests the State Board of Education to approve the updated language in the rule so that it will agree with the language in Florida Statutes and to approve the *Standards, Benchmarks, and Frameworks Career and Technical Education Frameworks, Academic Year 2008-2009* and *Curriculum Frameworks Adult General Education, 2007/2008*.
