BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Section 1011.32(12), Florida Statutes, Community College Facility Enhancement Challenge Grant Program, requires that, "a facility may not be named after a living person without prior approval by the State Board of Education." The Indian River Community College Board of Trustees and the college wish to honor the lead gift donor to enhance the construction of the Blackburn Educational Building at the Human Development and Resources Complex in Fort Pierce. The gift was from David and Ursula Blackburn. This request from the college is to comply with Statute.
