EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The *ACC Credit-By-Exam Equivalencies* list was initially adopted by the State Board of Education on November 14, 2001. The list has been maintained and reviewed annually by the ACC since the time of initial adoption—most recently approved by the State Board of Education in March, 2007 and the Board of Governors in May, 2007.

Modifications for the 2008 Credit-By-Exam Equivalencies are limited to the College Level Examination Program (CLEP), and include: (1) notices of termination of the *Principles of Accounting*, *College Algebra-Trigonometry*, and *Trigonometry* exams, which have been replaced by other examinations; and (2) changes to the level 2 cut-scores in French, German (pending approval), and Spanish Language examinations. The content of the examinations have not changed; instead, the College Board convened a panel of experts in each field to conduct a review of proper standards to derive these new cut-scores. These new cut-scores in French and Spanish have been endorsed by the American Council on Education. The modifications to the *ACC Credit-By-Exam Equivalencies* list were approved by the ACC on May 28, 2008.
