EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Proposed Rule 6D-4.002, President, is amended to require a master's or higher degree, current Certification in Hearing Impaired/Deaf Education or Visually Impaired and Certification in Educational Leadership/Administration and Supervision and ten years experience in an educational setting, five of which must be working with Hearing Impaired or Visually Impaired students with five years of supervisory experience. The specific duties of the President are removed from rule and placed in a job description made available at the Human Resources Management and Development Office of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind.

This rule was approved by the Board of Trustees of the Florida School for the Deaf and the Blind, consistent with authority given to them in Section 1002.36 (4)(c), Florida Statutes, at a meeting on June 6, 2008. The rule is submitted to the State Board of Education for approval or disapproval consistent with Section 1002.36(4)(c), Florida Statutes.
