**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Effective with the 1999-2000 fiscal year, Section 1011.62(1)(f)3, Florida Statutes, provides that funding on the basis of FTE membership beyond the 180-day regular term shall be provided in the FEFP only for students enrolled in juvenile justice education programs or in education programs for juveniles placed in secure facilities or programs under Section 985.19, Florida Statutes. The legislative action renders Rule 6A-1.04511 unnecessary.
