

## 2008-2009 Exclusive Authority Recommendations



On June 17, 2008, the State Board of Education voted to deny the Exclusive Authority applications submitted by the following districts: Baker, Bay, Bradford, Citrus, Clay, Duval, Flagler, Gilchrist, Holmes, Indian River, Jackson, Lee, Levy, Manatee, Martin, Pasco, Santa Rosa, Sumter, Suwannee, and Volusia.

The remaining sixteen (16) districts requested an informal hearing as provided for in the State Board Rule 6A-6.0783, FAC. Subsequently, Nassau and Putnam did not submit final written statements and did not participate in the hearings.

On August 19, 2008, the State Board voted to accept the Commissioner's recommendation to grant exclusivity to the following school districts: Broward, Hernando, Hillsborough, Polk, and Sarasota
