EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Section 1003.62(2)(a), Florida Statutes, states that "an academic performance-based charter school district shall operate in accordance with its charter and shall be exempt from certain State Board of Education rules and statutes if the State Board of Education determines such an exemption will assist the district in maintaining or improving its high-performing status [...]"

The Orange County School District requests an amendment to the Charter School District agreement approved by the State Board of Education on October 21, 2008. This amendment allows the district to be exempt from the Department of Education Castaldi requirement for determining the life span of a school building or facility.
