The Superintendent appointed a zoning committee representative of parents, teachers and administrators impacted by the closing of Belle Vue. Five meetings were held, each with the opportunity for public input, and the review of student and geographical data. The school board approved the recommendation of the committee on April 28, 2009. District should seriously consider teacher placement at schools where reassigned students are sent with the exception of reading and mathematics who are highly qualified and effective instructors, defined by students achieving learning gains over a three year period.	A plan was developed for the placement of teachers from Belle Vue, with priority on teachers following the student population and placing highly qualified teachers with the former Belle Vue students. Consideration was given to the teachers certifications, years of experience, contractual status, and the teachers own preference for placement. All teachers have been placed. Progress Monitoring data will be collected quarterly in the areas of reading, writing, math and science.
